### What was your goal and what did you achieve?

When I set out to do my project, I wanted to do composting around the Middle School area, which is a group of classes. I have set up the composting system and it's working at the moment. Every week our little buddies are bringing compost down that they have collected and we put it in the compost bin. We leave it there and turn it every so often. I worked with my teacher and he contributed by organizing funding for the compost bin.
