



Polina - School stall for Siberian Tigers

What was your goal and what did you achieve?

My main idea was to try and get the message to as many people about sustainability and the environment, especially around Siberian Tigers and how they are nearly extinct. So first I was gathering ideas about how to do it, and then because I was out of the country for quite a long time, I decided that I wanted to set up a stall, with money going to a fund.

So I went shopping with my friends and bought things like stationery that would definitely interest kids, and we had the stall yesterday and made a bit of money. My friends helped my buy things and gave me some ideas. They helped me set up the stall and sell things, and my teacher helped, and all classes and other teachers came to the stall. And I had brochures that people could take home to their families.

What is your biggest success so far?

The money that we made. I was actually really proud we made \$110.

Next steps

We're going send the money next week to a fund, and that's how it's going to end.

What did you enjoy most?

I most enjoyed selling the things, because I made some stuff myself and that sold out first thing, and I was just really proud that people wanted to buy stuff that I actually made myself.

What is your advice to other students?

Don't keep it to yourself, try to do something about it. Just spread the message across to people, because if many people know about it, there's going to be someone who will try and make a change about it.
